



Piedmont Park Pool Rules

- 1) No glass, sharp objects, or hazardous materials.
- 2) No running or rough play.
- 3) Shower and rinse thoroughly before entering the pool.
- 4) Children who have not been toilet trained are required to wear "swim" diapers. Regular diapers are prohibited.
- 5) Diving in shallow areas of the pool is strictly prohibited.
- 6) Children 11 and under must be accompanied by an adult.
- 7) Bathing attire must be worn on the pool deck.
- 8) Maximum Capacity: 150 persons.
- 9) Swimming is prohibited when lifeguard is not on duty.
- 10) No alcohol or amplified music without a permit.
- 11) All patrons are subject to search. All weapons (guns, knives, etc.) are prohibited.
- 12) Food and drink allowed in designated areas only.
- 13) No floats, swim fins, snorkels or toys.
- 14) No spitting, spouting or blowing nose in pool.
- 15) Bathers with communicable conditions or open wounds are not allowed.
- 16) No smoking.
- 17) No animals other than service animals without a permit.
- 18) Damage to property will not be permitted and violators will be held responsible.
- 19) Swimming will be delayed for a minimum of 30 minutes in case of thunder or lightning.
